What to expect?

We start the worship service with praise and worship songs, followed by an opening prayer and a call to worship hymn. Next, will be a welcome and announcements to keep us informed about upcoming events and programs notices. Next up, will be a celebration of any birthdays and anniversaries.

The next portion of the service will be Praises and Prayer Requests, followed by an offertory hymn, and worship with tithes and offerings. It is at this time our Heaven Bound choir will sing. The children will then leave for Children's Church. Our pastor will then give his message from God's Word that is relevant and meaningful to our lives.

Our aim is that whether you are looking at being a Christian for the first time or have been a Christian for many years that you should be encouraged and inspired by attending our worship service.
